Mathematics:

Sample Question (with solution):

A bookstore sold books worth **Rs. 23,450** in January and **Rs. 18,320** in February.

- What is the total amount of sales in the two months?
- If the bookstore spent **Rs. 30,000** on buying new books, how much money is left?

Solution:

- Total sales = Rs. 23,450 + Rs. 18,320 = **Rs. 41,770**
- Money left = Rs. 41,770 – Rs. 30,000 = **Rs. 11,770**

1. A farmer harvested **Rs. 35,625** worth of crops in March and **Rs. 27,480** in April.

- Find the total earning for these two months.
- After spending Rs. 40,000 on farm tools, how much money is left?

2. A school received donations of Rs. **42,750** in May and Rs. **36,500** in June.

- What is the total amount of donations received?
- If Rs. 50,000 was used to buy sports equipment, what is the remaining amount?

3. A shopkeeper had Rs. **50,000** at the beginning of the month. He earned Rs. **24,650** more during the month and spent Rs. **38,700**.

- How much money did he have after the earnings?
- How much money was left after his spending?
